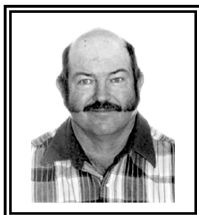

ENTRY: Entries close Aug. 3. Entries must be postmarked by this date. **LATE ENTRIES will not be accepted unless ample space is available.** If accepted, they will be charged a double entry fee **and entry MUST be received by Aug. 9.** You may submit your entry forms online. **Online deadline is Aug. 9.** Payment must be made with entry. Visa and MasterCard accepted. www.idahofair.com. A \$2 per exhibitor convenience fee applies.

1. The Management reserves the right to close entries whenever available space is filled. Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Western Idaho Fair. Entry forms must be completely filled out and must include the name and registration number of all animals entered and the names and registration numbers of both sire and dam. Substitutions will be allowed until 10:00 a.m. the day of Fair judging. **RINGSIDE ENTRIES ARE PROHIBITED.**

BOARS & GILTS must be Purebred. **MARKET SWINE** may be Purebred or Crossbred. In all classes, **ALL BREEDS WILL SHOW TOGETHER.** Exhibitors may make as many entries in each class as desired, but no exhibitor will be allowed more than **TWO** premiums per

class. Competition consists of two or more exhibitors, not from a family group unless swine are owned by different family members and raised on different farms.

2. **FEES:** \$5.00 per animal will be charged (\$10.00 per animal if late). A maximum of four animals per pen will be allowed. **No refunds on entry fees.**
3. **PASSES:** Each exhibitor may purchase two exhibitor tickets for personal use at a cost of \$15.00 each. A helper's pass may be purchased for \$15.00 for every three animals entered. **Remittance** for entry fees and exhibitor passes **must accompany entries.**
4. **PARKING:** Livestock exhibitors will be issued two vehicle parking permits. Exhibitor with pass must display parking permit in vehicle window for admittance at **LIVESTOCK ENTRANCE ON BACKSTRETCH BLVD. OFF GLENWOOD ST.** Designated parking areas for Livestock Exhibitors must be used. **NO VEHICULAR MOVEMENT** will be allowed inside the paid admission area during the hours the Fair is open to the public - (11:00 a.m. to midnight). Exception to this rule will be **OPEN CLASS** Livestock Release

times on SUNDAY and MONDAY, Aug. 23 & 24, and on SUNDAY, Aug. 30. **Vehicles will not be allowed to enter this area after 10 a.m.** Vehicles bringing in livestock, feed, equipment etc. **MUST be removed to the parking area before 11:00 a.m.**

If needed, FAIR PERSONNEL WILL DELIVER ITEMS FROM THE VEHICLE PARKING AREA TO THE BARN AREA DURING THE HOURS THE FAIR IS OPEN.

5. **CAMPING:** Overnight camping for livestock exhibitors is available on the fairgrounds at the **On the River R.V. Park** only. By contract, 25 spaces are set aside at \$13.75 per day for full electrical, sewer and water hook-ups. (Regular price is

\$31.00.) The Western Idaho Fair will subsidize additionally needed spaces at the discounted rate to encourage livestock exhibitor participation. **In order to take advantage of this offer, you must call ON THE RIVER R. V. PARK, at 6000 Glenwood, Boise, ID 83714 (Phone 208-375-7432). Make your reservation and forward full payment no later than Aug. 1.** Due to contractual obligations with the **On the River R.V. Park, all other camping on fairgrounds property is prohibited unless specifically authorized by a livestock Superintendent and registered through the Western Idaho Fair Premium Office.** License plate numbers of exhibitors who are authorized by Superintendents to watch animals at night will be registered with Security.

6. **ARRIVAL:** Open Class Swine may arrive Wednesday, Aug. 25 from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. **Any change from specified arrival time must have special permission from the Department Superintendent.**
7. **JUDGING:** Open Class Swine will be judged Wednesday, Aug. 25 at 7:00 p.m.
8. **RELEASE:** Swine exhibits must remain in place until 8:00 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 29. A "**Release Slip**" from the Department Superintendent will be required for transportation of livestock from the grounds.
9. **ALL BREEDS WILL SHOW TOGETHER.** Each animal will be judged against the ideal standard for its particular breed. All animals shall be the property of the Exhibitor and where applicable shall so appear on the records of their respective breed associations at the date of entry.
10. Boars over 6 months old must have their tusks removed.
11. **Pens must be kept clean at all times and be adequately bedded with shavings.**
12. Prior to judging, the Superintendent will inspect all exhibits in the department to determine if they are entered in the class in which they should compete. In cases where it is obvious that entries are not correctly posted due to clerical error, the Superintendent must contact the Premium Office in order for a change to be made.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

Swine must be sound, in good health, and free of communicable diseases. Instate swine must have a veterinary certificate of general soundness and good health.

All swine for breeding or sale purposes at the Fair must be from a validated free and Pseudorabies Stage IV or V State or be Brucellosis and Pseudorabies tested. Out-of-state swine must meet Idaho import requirements. Certificates of veterinary inspection should be dated no earlier than 30 days prior to arrival at the Western Idaho Fair. All swine are subject to inspection at the Fairgrounds.

Important Note: Exhibitors are requested to carefully read the rules and regulations in the front of the premium book.

All market swine to be shown will be weighed on Wednesday, Aug. 25, between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. Barrows weighing plus or minus five pounds from the weight limit can be shown in either weight class determined by the exhibitor.
