How to enter:

Bring in your entries with the entry form(s) to the fairgrounds on **Monday, August 16 or Tuesday, August 17 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days you have the following 2 options:

1. **a.** Mail or deliver **ONLY** your **entry form(s)** to the Premium Office, 5610 Glenwood, Boise ID 83714 by **August 9.**
 - b.** Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on August 16 or August 17 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

2. **a.** Enter online by **August 9** at www.idahofair.com. Follow the link to Competitive Exhibits.
A \$2 fee will apply. This fee is per exhibitor, regardless of number of entries or in how many departments you enter.
 - b.** Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on August 16 or August 17 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

ALL ARTWORK MUST BE READY TO HANG WITH A SUITABLE WIRE HANGER. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS CAN BE ACCEPTED DUE TO HANGING PROCESS. ALL ARTWORK MUST BE COMPLETELY DRY.

1. Entries will be received in the **NORTH WING** of the Exposition Building. Entries must be made on forms provided by the Western Idaho Fair. Specify type of medium used. **SENIOR EXHIBITORS** (62 and older) must specify "**SENIOR**" on entry form to be eligible for special Senior Award.
There will be three Divisions for Exhibition: Division 1- Professional; Division 2-Amateur; and Division 3- Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities. All artists in the Northwest, **18 years of age and over**, are encouraged to enter.

DIVISION 1 - Professional:

Professional Class is open to any artist who sells their art or teaches art. A **\$4.00 entry fee** will be charged for each item entered. Professional artwork **MUST BE COMPLETELY ORIGINAL. No plagiarism, prints, copies or works done with the assistance of computers.**

DIVISION 2 - Amateur:

Amateur refers to those who make their artwork for their own pleasure and do not intend to sell. Anyone wishing to enter the exhibition is welcome to enter in this class. Students and class participants are welcome to enter. No prints, copies, or work done with the assistance of computers will be accepted. There is no entry fee charged in the Amateur Division.

DIVISION 3 – Persons with Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities:

Anyone with developmental or intellectual disabilities is welcome to enter this class. If the artistry of an exhibit surpasses the intent of this division, the item will be reclassified to keep the competition fair for the truly disabled competitor. No paint by numbers or other kits will be allowed. There is no entry fee charged in this Division.

2. **JUDGING:** Thursday, Aug. 19-10:00 a.m. This area will be closed during Judging. Awards will be given out at the discretion of the Judges according to the merit of article.
3. **PREMIUM PAY-OUT:** AWARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE **PREMIUM OFFICE**. A COPY OF THE **EXHIBITOR NUMBER FORM** SHOULD BE PRESENTED FOR PREMIUM PAY-OUT. Cash premiums will be paid to those entitled to awards on Aug. 24 through Aug. 29 from 12 Noon to 8:00 p.m. and on Exhibit Release day, Monday, Aug. 30 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Starting Aug. 31 through Sept. 9, awards will be given out from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. The Office will be closed for the Labor Day weekend. **Awards not claimed by Sept. 9, 2010** will be considered a donation and will revert back to the Western Idaho Fair general fund.
4. **RELEASE:** Monday, Aug. 30-10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. **NO EXHIBITS WILL BE REMOVED BEFORE 10:00 A.M. MONDAY, AUG. 30.** Exhibits which are not claimed within one week after the close of the Fair will be considered to have been abandoned and will be disposed of as the Manager of the Fair sees fit.

Exhibitors must present claim checks corresponding with entry tags when claiming exhibits. Exhibits must not be removed without the Superintendent or assistants being present to check out entries.

RULES: No piece will be rejected as long as the entry is done in good taste and meets all other specifications. The Superintendent reserves the right to reject any artwork that would not be suitable for viewing by all ages.

The artist or his/her authorized agent must enter items. Any person, not an employee or officer of the Western Idaho Fair is eligible to act as an agent. **NO** works shipped to the Fair will be accepted.

Artwork Dimension - The total of all four sides must not exceed 200 inches including the frame. **Art work must have been completed in the last two years.** Items cannot be entered for exhibition for more than one year.

ALL ARTWORK MUST BE READY TO HANG WITH A SUITABLE WIRE HANGER. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS CAN BE ACCEPTED DUE TO HANGING PROCESS. ALL ARTWORK MUST BE COMPLETELY DRY.

A maximum of **THREE** entries will be accepted in all divisions, but **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER CLASS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

All articles entered shall be under the control of the Superintendent of this department. Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of the exhibits, **but the artist assumes all responsibility in case of loss or theft and in no case will the Management of the Western Idaho Fair or the Superintendent be responsible for loss or damage.**

Exhibitors are requested to read the General Rules and Regulations of this Fair. Special department rules supersede General Rules.

A CARD MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF EACH ENTRY SHOWING NAME, ADDRESS AND MEDIUM. In case of an "Idaho Landscape", artwork must also indicate the location.

SALES RESTRICTIONS: Exhibitors wishing to sell artwork may so notify the Superintendent. Prices, business cards or internet addresses **CANNOT** appear on the exhibit. The superintendent or the management of the Western Idaho Fair will not be responsible for collection of money or delivery of exhibit. Sales transactions will be the responsibility of the artist.

SPECIAL AWARDS

PURCHASE AWARD: Upon agreement with the artist, the **WESTERN IDAHO FAIR** will purchase a piece from the exhibition at a price not exceeding \$500. A plaque will also be awarded. **The purchased work of art becomes the property of the Western Idaho Fair** and will be displayed permanently at the Fairgrounds or other county office, assuring the artist's work an honored and permanent place of exhibition.

THE WESTERN IDAHO FAIR will award the following:

THEME AWARD-a plaque will be awarded for the art exhibit that best portrays the **Fair Theme "BARNYARD BALL"**.

JUDGE'S CHOICE-Professional Art. The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon. Open to all classes.

JUDGE'S CHOICE-Amateur Art. The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon. Open to all classes.

BEST IDAHO LANDSCAPE-any media. Only those entries labeled with a specific Idaho location will be eligible. The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST STILL LIFE-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST OIL PAINTING-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST WATER COLOR-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST ACRYLIC-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST OTHER MEDIA-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

BEST OF "ALL OTHER" MEDIA-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

SENIOR CITIZEN AWARD-(age 62 and over)-The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon. (In order to compete for this award, exhibitor must indicate "Senior" on entry form.)

BEST OF SHOW-(Overall-Best Piece of Art) The winner will receive a Plaque and Special Ribbon.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE OF THE DAY-Each day of the Fair visitors may vote for their favorite artwork. At the end of each day the entry receiving the most votes will receive a special ribbon and \$5. An entry can win only ONE TIME.
