Entries must be made on forms supplied by Western Idaho Fair. All **ENTRIES** must be signed by parent or guardian. Please indicate present age of exhibitor on entry form. Only **ONE** entry per class will be accepted per exhibitor. No item previously entered in the Western Idaho Fair may be re-entered. Exhibitors are requested to carefully read the General Rules and Regulations of this Fair. Department Rules supersede General Rules. Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of the exhibits, but the **entrant assumes all responsibility in case of loss, theft or damage and in no case will the Management of the Fair or the Superintendent be held responsible.** Exhibits must have been made in the last 12 months.
- 2. JUDGING:** Agriculture & Flower Divisions will be judged Aug. 19. Other Divisions will be judged Aug. 18.
- 3. PREMIUM PAY-OUT:** AWARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE **PREMIUM OFFICE**. COPY OF **EXHIBITOR'S NUMBER FORM** SHOULD BE PRESENTED FOR PREMIUM PAY-OUT. Cash premiums will be paid to those entitled to awards on Aug. 24 through Aug. 29 from 12 Noon to 8:00 p.m. and on Exhibit Release day, **MONDAY, Aug. 30** 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Starting Aug. 31 through Sept. 9, awards will be given out from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. The Office will be closed for Labor Day weekend. **Awards not claimed by Sept. 9, 2010** will be considered a donation and will revert back to the Western Idaho Fair general fund.
- 4. RELEASE:** **MONDAY, Aug. 30** 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. **IN NO CASE MAY EXHIBITS BE REMOVED BEFORE 10:00 A.M. MONDAY, AUG. 30.** Exhibits which are not claimed within one week after the close of the Fair will be

considered to have been abandoned and will be disposed of as the fair manager sees fit.

**Exhibitors must present claim checks** corresponding with entry tags when claiming exhibits. Exhibits must not be removed without the Superintendent or assistants being present to check out entries.

2. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MATTED OR MOUNTED ON CARDBOARD. (AGE 12-17 MAY FRAME ART WORK, BUT MUST HAVE A SECURE WIRE HANGER-NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.) The Superintendent shall have the right to either 1) Refuse any entry not meeting these requirements or 2) Use STAPLES, PINS or other method of display that could possibly mar the entry.
