DIVISIONS 1 THROUGH 8

How to enter:
Bring your entries with the entry form(s) to the fairgrounds on **Monday, Aug. 15 and Tuesday Aug. 16 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days, you have the following 2 options:
1.a. Mail or deliver **ONLY** your **entry form (s)** to the Premium Office, 5610 Glenwood, Boise, ID 83714 by **Aug. 9.**
b. Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on Aug. 15 or Aug. 16 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
or 2.a. Enter online by **Aug. 9** at www.idahofair.com. Follow the link to Competitive Exhibits. A \$2 fee will apply. This fee is per exhibitor, regardless of number of entries or in how many departments you enter.
b. Bring your **entries** to the fairgrounds on Aug. 15 or Aug. 16 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

1. **ENTRY:** Entry days vary within this department. **Please read carefully.** Entries will be received in the **North Wing** of the Exposition Building. Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Western Idaho Fair. All entries must be signed by parent or guardian. Please indicate present age of exhibitor on entry forms. Only **ONE** entry per class will be accepted per exhibitor. No item previously entered in the Western Idaho Fair may be re-entered. Exhibitors are requested to carefully read the General Rules and Regulations of this Fair. Department Rules supersede General Rules. Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of the exhibits, but the **entrant assumes all responsibility in case of loss, theft or damage and in no case will the Management of the Fair or the Superintendent be held responsible.** Exhibits must have been made in the last 12 months.
2. **JUDGING:** Agriculture & Flower Divisions will be judged Aug. 18. Other Divisions will be judged Aug. 17.
3. **PREMIUM PAY-OUT:** Awards will be available at the Premium Office. Copy of Exhibitor's number form should be presented for premium pay-out. Cash premiums will be paid to those entitled to awards on Aug. 23 through Aug. 28 from 12 Noon to 8:00 p.m. and on Exhibit Release day, Monday, Aug. 29 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Starting Aug. 30 through Sept. 8, awards will be given out from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. The Office will be closed for Labor Day weekend. **Awards not claimed by Sept. 8, 2011** will be considered a donation and will revert back to the Western Idaho Fair general fund.
4. **RELEASE:** Monday, Aug. 29 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. **In no case may exhibits be removed before 10:00 a.m. Monday, Aug. 29.** Exhibits which are not claimed within one week after the close of the Fair will be considered to have been abandoned and will be disposed of as the Fair Manager sees fit.
Exhibitors must present claim checks corresponding with entry tags when claiming exhibits. Exhibits must not be removed without the Superintendent or assistants being present to check out entries.

We recommend that hot glue not be used on entries. Hot glue relaxes at 80 degrees.
1. All artwork must be **ORIGINAL** – no traced, copied or computerized items.
 2. All entries must be matted or mounted on cardboard. (Age 12-17 may frame art work, but must have a secure wire hanger – **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.**) The Superintendent shall have the right to either 1) refuse any entry not meeting these requirements or 2) use **STAPLES, PINS** or other method of display that could possibly mar the entry.
 3. The Superintendent shall have the right to refuse any exhibit of offensive nature.
 4. Only **TWO** items may be entered in this division per exhibitor, only **one** per class.
 5. No computer-made art will be accepted.

6. If an article or type of work is listed in the numbered classes, the same type of work may NOT be entered in any "other than listed" or "miscellaneous" class.

Each jar **MUST BE NEATLY LABELED**, giving name of product, date canned, type of pack (raw or hot pack), **PROCESSING METHOD** (boiling water canner or pressure canner), **PROCESSING TIME AND POUNDS OF PRESSURE.** Be sure to use appropriate altitude adjustments, i.e. pressure canning-15# pressure for weighted gauge; 12# pressure for dial gauge for altitude in Treasure Valley. Please list altitude for your canning entry.
