1. Western Idaho Fair Rules 1, 4, 5, 6 and the Health Requirements listed in the Dairy Goat Division (preceding) will apply to Pygmy Goats. Additionally, all Pygmy Goats must be dehorned/disbudded – no horned animals may be exhibited. All animals must be properly cared for and in good condition. Animals shown in Wether Classes must not show characteristics of any breed other than Pygmy Goat. The Management reserves the right to remove from the grounds or from the display any animal it deems unsuitable for exhibition. Please carefully read the **Rules and Regulations** at the front of this Premium Book and all rules in this section.

2. **FEES:** An entry fee of \$10.00 per pen will be charged (\$20.00 per pen if late.) Pens are 6' x 6'. Pygmy goats will be allowed a maximum of 4 adults or 6 kids per pen. **Each exhibitor must pay a pen fee.**

Do not enclose pen fees for tack pens. There is no charge for tack pens. They will be available **ONLY** after all animals have been assigned pens. Tack space when assigned must be shared if necessary.

3. **Entries and Eligibility for Premiums:**

- **For Classes 1 – 4:** Include the name and age of exhibitor.
- **For Classes 5 – 26** (Champion classes excluded): include the full name of the animal, date of birth, sire and dam, and (for NPGA Classes) registration number. See class descriptions of 31 – 33 for entry form requirements. Please double-check your animal's paperwork against your entry form.

In addition to other applicable rules in this premium book, **each Pygmy Goat exhibitor must have paid a pen fee** under his/her name, as an individual Open Class Pygmy Goat exhibitor, to claim a premium in the Open Show.

Note: 4-H/FFA Pygmy Goat exhibitors are welcome and encouraged to compete in the Open Show, **but EACH must submit an Open Class Livestock entry form and pay the fees applicable for open classes.** See the Junior Exhibitors Handbook for more information about the 4-H/FFA Show.

4. **CAMPING:** Overnight camping for livestock exhibitors is **ONLY** available on the fairgrounds at **Boise Riverside RV Park**. To take advantage of the special Fair rate, for the first 50 spaces, of \$20 per day for full electrical, sewer and water hook-ups you must contact Boise Riverside RV Park, 6000 N. Glenwood, Boise, 83714. Phone: (208)375-7432. Website: www.BoiseRiversideRVPark.com. **Make your reservations and forward full payment no later than Aug. 1. All other camping on fairgrounds property is prohibited unless specifically authorized by a Livestock Superintendent and registered through the Western Idaho Fair Premium**

Office. License plate numbers of exhibitors who are authorized by Superintendent to watch animals at night will be registered with Security.

5. **PARKING:** Livestock exhibitors will be issued two vehicle parking permits. Exhibitor with pass must display parking permit in vehicle window for admittance at the **Livestock Entrance** off of Backstretch Blvd. at **Glenwood Street**. Designated parking areas for Livestock Exhibitors must be used. **NO vehicular movement** will be allowed inside the paid admission area during the hours the Fair is open to the public – (Noon to Midnight). Exception to this rule will be **Open Class Livestock Release times on Sunday and Monday, Aug. 21 & 22, and on Sunday, Aug. 28.**

Vehicles will not be allowed to enter this area after 10 a.m. Vehicles bringing in livestock, feed, equipment etc. **MUST be removed to the parking area before 11:00 a.m.**

If needed, **Fair personnel will deliver items from the vehicle parking area to the barn area during the hours the Fair is open.**

6. **ARRIVAL TIME:** Pygmy Goat exhibitors may arrive Thursday evening, Aug. 18, but must be on the grounds before 10:00 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 19. Placement of livestock will be determined by the Show Chairperson. In the event of any conflict, the decision of the Department Superintendent or the Livestock Director will be final. **Animals will be health checked by Show Chairman before entering the barn.**

7. **RELEASE:** Pygmy Goat exhibits will be released at 10:00 p.m. on Monday, Aug. 22 and **must be out** of the barn by 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 23. Any exhibitor who removes, allows to be removed, or participates in the removal of a Pygmy Goat from the fairgrounds site without the Chairperson's, Superintendent's or Livestock Director's express written permission may be barred from future exhibitor participation at the Western Idaho Fair, and will immediately forfeit any premiums awarded.
8. **National Pygmy Goat Association (NPGA) rules will govern all Pygmy Goat Classes and supersede all other rules.** Only NPGA-registered does may compete in the NPGA-sanctioned doe and group classes. All tattooing must be done before commencement of the sanctioned show. For NPGA-sanctioned classes, the animal's original NPGA registration certificate shall be presented to the Show Chairperson for examination at check-in and must be available for the judge's inspection at show time. NPGA rosettes will be issued only to NPGA animals; Western Idaho Fair rosettes will be issued to all champions.
9. **Show check-in and substitutions:** All open show exhibitors must check in with the Pygmy Goat Show Chairperson Friday evening, Aug. 19, between the hours of 6:30 – 7:30 p.m. **NO check-ins will be done on Saturday!** All substitutions must be made at or before the check-in times and must be approved by the Pygmy Goat Chairperson.

Group Classes – NPGA Registered Does Only

31. Get-of-Sire: To consist of three does, all the daughters of one sire. One Get-of-Sire class per sire, and no more than two sires per exhibitor. If more than one exhibitor combines animals for this class, premium will be paid only to the exhibitor who submitted the sire entry. Sire's name, NPGA number, and the number of daughters to be shown must appear on the entry form; daughters' names and NPGA numbers to be provided to the show chair at check-in.
32. Dam and Daughter(s): To consist of dam and 1 to 3 daughters. Dam's name, NPGA number, and the number of daughters in the exhibit must appear on the entry form; daughter(s)' name(s) and NPGA number(s) to be provided to the show chair at check-in. Premium will be paid to exhibitor who currently owns dam, as indicated on the entry form.
33. Breeder's Trio: Entry will consist of 3 does, at least one of which is a senior, and all of which must have been bred by and currently owned by the exhibitor. Exhibitor's herd name should appear on the entry form; does' names and NPGA numbers to be provided to the show chair at check-in.
34. **Premier Breeder.....Banner**
35. **Premier Exhibitor.....Banner**

Premier Breeder Award: This award to be made to the breeder winning the most points in the **individual** classes on the top eight (8) animals **bred** by him and exhibited by him or others.

Premier Exhibitor Award: This award to be made to the exhibitor winning the most points in the **individual** classes on the top eight (8) animals **owned and exhibited** by him.

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor awards will be given only when there is competition between two or more exhibitors.
