373 Beef (All ground minimum internal temperature of 165° F and Steaks, etc. 145° F) Judging 2 pm

374 Poultry (minimum internal temperature of 165° F) Judging 3 pm

375 Pork (cooked to a minimum temperature of 160° F) Judging 4 pm

376 Fish (cooked to a minimum temperature of 145°) Judging 5 pm

Rules:

- ✓ Grills must be propane, briquette or electric only and should be provided by the contestant. However, there is a limited number of propane grills available on a first come, first served basis. Call to reserve.
- ✓ All ingredients and additional equipment i.e.: coolers, etc., must be supplied by the contestant.
- ✓ Move-in and move-out requirements (see following map). Contestants who are providing their own grill must drop and go at the competition area located at the Demostation Building. Enter grounds via Gate 7 (Backstretch Gate) by 9:30 am. All vehicles must be removed from grounds by 10 am. No exceptions! To remove your grill at contest end, you **must not leave** grounds with your equipment until 8 pm. This will be strictly enforced. Exit at Gate 7.
- ✓ All carry/roll onto grounds: Enter via Gate 41 (4-H Gate). There will be some shuttle available on a limited basis.
- ✓ Livestock parking passes will be provided for your convenience.
- ✓ Please provide a fire extinguisher. Some are available on site. Please call to reserve.
- ✓ In the event of dangerous weather, the Competition will be cancelled.
- ✓ All classes will be under the control of the Department Superintendent. Every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of this contest but the exhibitor assumes all responsibility in case of loss or theft and in no case will the management of Western Idaho Fair of the Superintendent be held responsible.
