DIVISION 11 – WINE

Attention: This competition will be held prior to the start of the Fair for Professional entries only.

Note: All Amateur entries must be received during Agriculture entry day Tuesday, August 13 **ONLY** between 11:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Open to all amateur and professional wine makers who will be at least 21 years of age on June 1, 2019

Categories may be collapsed or expanded at the discretion of the judges.

How to enter:

1. Each **Amateur** wine entry must consist of 1 – 375 ml or 500 ml bottle. Secure an official Registration Tag to each bottle with a rubber band. (See entry dates above)
2. Each **Professional** wine entry must consist of 2 or 3 – 375 ml or 500 ml bottles (3 preferred). Please contact Agriculture Superintendent Teresa Biggs for more information on how to enter.
3. This wine competition is judged based on the UC Davis Scoring System.
4. See the links on the website or contact the Premium Office for the Wine Registration Tags and the UC Davis Scoring System.

The decision of entry registrars and judges are final.

Awards will be provided.

How to enter:

Bring in your entries with the entry form(s) to the Fairgrounds on **Tuesday, Aug. 13 or Wednesday, Aug. 14 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Entries will be taken in the North Expo Building. If you want to enter early and reduce time spent in line on entry days, you have the following 2 options:

6. a) Mail or deliver **ONLY** your **entry form(s)** to the Premium Office, 5610 Glenwood, Boise ID 83714 by **August 8.**
b) Then bring your **entries** to the Fairgrounds on **Aug. 13 or Aug. 14** from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

OR 2. a) Enter online by **Aug. 8** at www.idahofair.com. Follow the link to Competitive Exhibits. Starting this year the Western Idaho Fair will cover the \$2 convenience fee. There will be no charge to enter online unless a professional fee applies.
